1. Called to order 7:10pm
2. Committee members participating:

4. Announcements –
 - a. Cindy encouraged everyone to join in to as many Zoom Committee meeting as possible.
 - b. Noted that one of the next Zoom Committee meetings coming up would be the General Board meeting on June 10.

5. Budge/Funding:
 - a. Sandy Capps, the STNC Treasurer is working on the Encumbrance amounts to be voted on at the next Budget meeting May 27.
 - b. Richard, LUC, will be looking to determine the cost of email service tied to the Doman name for the LUC members.
6. Restaurant Beverage Ordinance - To fast track Conditional Use Permits for Restaurants wanting to service Alcohol.
 - a. A recorded presentation from LA City Planning was played giving all the high point of this Ordinance, listing the 50 conditions the restaurant must meet and keep.
 - b. A few of stakeholders made comments that the City should also have as one of the conditions that a Plant-Based menu must be expanded.
 - c. Not sure when this Ordinance will be voted on but you can submit your comments to Roberto.luna@lacity.org
7. Pending and New Land projects:
 - a. Briefly went over two projects still pending with the City; one did not show up at a meeting, assume they have backed off and 3 either the property owner or neighbors called for info.
 - b. Since the March 2 meeting, there have not been any new projects submitted to Planning that would come under STNC jurisdiction.
