Re: Discussion and Motion:

To submit a Community Impact Statement (CIS) in response to Council File 21-0008-S18 regarding Sherman Grove Avenue / Le Berthon Street / Hillrose Street Oversized Vehicle Parking Restrictions.

Dear Councilmember Monica Rodriguez, Transportation Committee, and Los Angeles City Council:

The Sunland-Tujunga Neighborhood Council voted to SUPORT this Council File. We took this position because:

- 1. Neighbors and stakeholders have repeatedly reached out to STNC representatives for many months expressing their frustrations/fear of this ongoing dangerous situation. There was one permanent RV and now there are two permanent RVs.
- 2. Public sidewalks are blocked since the RV residents have set up awnings, tarps, boxes, barrels, bags, and furniture on the sidewalk (see attached pictures). People cannot walk or pass through with wheelchairs, strollers, bicycles, etc.
- 3. There is limited parking for these tax paying home residents. They have to park blocks away hauling their groceries and children.
- 4. It is dangerous to turn right or left from Forsythe Street onto Sherman Grove Avenue since the RVs block drivers' vision.
- 5. There is suspected drug dealing and harassment. LAPD has been notified and involved. There are many children who live on this street and like to walk to nearby Sunland Park.
- 6. Feces/urine/trash/waste water are dumped onto the street, sidewalk, storm drains, and gutters. This is unsanitary and neighbors complain about the stench.

Thank you Councilmembers Monica Rodriguez and Nury Martinez for presenting this resolution. We look forward to having these parking restrictions signs posted and hopefully enforced for the sake of our community members.
