- 1. **Call To Order; Introductions, Approval of Minutes of February 28, 2023:** Committee Chair, Joe DeCenzo convened the meeting at 7:33 p.m. He invited the guests to introduce themselves then read through the minutes of February 28th. Michelle Wadler moved to approve the minutes as corrected. KT Travers seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0 with 1 abstention.
- 2. **Review mission statement; Code of Conduct; Quorum requirements:** Joe summarized the STARC mission statement as listed on the STNC website. Our quorum requirement is 5. Specifics of the code of conduct can be found on the D.O.N.E website: www.empowerla.org
- 3. **Public Comments/Updates for Non-Agenda Items**: Lucy Berman mentioned that "Hanukkah in the Foothills is scheduled for Thursday, December 14, 2023 (the 8th night.) She has contacted the office of Monica Rodriguez about using north valley city hall as the venue. KT announced that S-T Forward has adopted the median at Pali and Foothill Blvd. They will install a native plant garden and accept proposals from artists who are interested in installing projects on the median.
