# Selection Process & Payment

A diverse committee of local stakeholders will select the finalists and present these to the STNC Board for its final vote. For fairness, no judge will know any artist's name, thus no name should be on your artwork.

Once winners are selected, final artwork is sent in, the legal release is signed and returned, artists will be paid \$400.

There will be a total of 5 winners. Only 1 winning entry per artist.

#### **Work Media**

Artwork can be in any medium transferable to the banners' portrait format. Examples are, but not limited to, photography, watercolor, acrylic, oil painting, collage, or pastel.

#### **Theme**

Artists' subjects should represent Sunland-Tujunga and our unique neighborhoods, history/heritage, architecture, flora, fauna. Okay to "recycle" your earlier work.

#### **What to Submit**

Your initial art submission must be a .pdf with your name as part of its filename along with your application. To ensure impartiality, do not include your name on the artwork. Winning artists must submit their final file in one of these formats: ai .eps .pdf .indd .tiff .psd, .jpeg or png. Minimum 150 dpi but 300 dpi preferred.

#### **Banner Size, Messaging:**

Banner size: 3' x 8'. Art will cover 3' x 6' 4" (approx.) with city required STNC message on bottom. Your name will appear on the banner.

#### **Submission Process**

You must complete the Artist's Application and email it with your .pdfs no later than Saturday, March 27. Find application here: STNC.org Email: STArtBanners@vahoo.com
