Please note that under the Brown Act, the Board is prevented from acting on a matter that you bring to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, the issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Board meeting. Public comment is limited to (1) One minutes per speaker, unless adjusted by the presiding officer of the Board.

This amount of \$100,000 will allow our community of Sunland-Tujunga to further fund Community Food Banks, Multi-Cultural Events, Traffic Safety Education, Public Schools and After School programs through Neighborhood Purpose Grants and Community Improvement Projects. Funding Neighborhood Councils allow us to distribute to groups and organizations that we know assist the community. Neighborhood Councils are the most comprehensive systems of self-governance in the country. We have direct links, live and experiences, and connections to the communities we serve. No one is excluded from participation regardless of gender, citizenship, or social status. So we ask that you support CF 20-0692.
